
## Criteria For Referral For Possible Rib Fracture Fixation



- 1.  $\geq$  6 ribs fractured
- 2. Flail chest
- 3. Bilateral fractures
- 4.  $\geq$  3 ribs with bicortical displacement
- 5. Inadequate pulmonary toilet
- 6. Volume loss in hemithorax
- 7. Severe displacement of any rib
- 8. Progressive thoracic volume loss or worsening displacement on imaging
- 9. Inadequate pain control to allow IS ≥ 15 ml/kg
- 10. Mechanical Instability (paradoxical respiration)
- 11. Concomitant intrathoracic pathology (Retained hemothorax, suspected diaphragm injury)
