Neurosurgical Consultation Guideline for Trauma

Consult the neurosurgeon if:

 GCS ≤ 8 with any CT scan finding indicating brain injury or hemorrhage;

or

• Any GCS <u>and</u> any one or more of the following CT scan findings or clinical risk factors:

CT Scan Findings

- 1. Depressed skull fracture > 1 cm
- 2. Basilar skull fracture or fracture involving posterior table of frontal sinus
- 3. Midline shift \geq 4 mm
- 4. Cerebral contusions
 - Solitary if \ge 10 mm
 - Multiple if two or more are \ge 5mm
- 5. Subarachnoid hemorrhage \geq 5 mm
- 6. Acute subdural hemorrhage
 - Thickness > 5 mm
 - Thickness < 5 mm in patients taking anticoagulants or antiplatelet medications (including aspirin)
- 7. Epidural hemorrhage > 5 mm thickness

Clinical Risk Factors

- 1. CSF Leak (nose or ear)
- 2. Penetrating intracranial trauma
- 3. New focal neurologic deficit
- 4. New pupil asymmetry
- 5. New dysconjugate gaze
- 6. Objective hemiparesis
